

DTC Presents Harvard Music Professor

Dwight Andrews To Give Lecture And Discuss Blues Music

The Dallas Theater Center continues its Deloitte & Touche In Perspective Series on Monday, February 24, with musician and Harvard professor, Dwight Andrews. Mr. Andrews has recently been appointed as the first Quincy Jones Professor of African American Music at Harvard. Best known as the musical director for all of the original productions of August Wilson's plays, Mr. Andrews is also an active jazz performer. Mr. Andrews will present a lecture demonstration on the history and influence of the blues in connection with Keith Glover's "blusical" *Thunder Knocking on the Door* (February 13 through March 9 at the Kalita Humphreys Theater). DTC Dramaturg Walter Bilderback will moderate.

The discussion will take place on Monday, February 24, at 7:00 p.m. in the Kalita Humphreys Theater, 3636 Turtle Creek Boulevard. The De-

loitte & Touche In Perspective Series is free and open to the public.

Dwight Andrews received his musical training at the University of Michigan and his Ph.D. in Music Theory and Divinity from Yale University. In addition to his work with playwright August Wilson, Mr. Andrews is a Resident Artist at the Alliance Theater in Atlanta and a faculty member at Emory University.

He is on leave this semester to teach in Harvard's Afro-American Studies and Music Programs. Mr. Andrews has recently been named Artistic Director of the National Black Arts Festival, which occurs biennially in Atlanta.

Now in its third season, the Deloitte & Touche In Perspective Series presents nationally recognized speakers who lead in-depth discussions about each DTC mainstage production. Each program focuses on one or more elements of the play and the context in which it was written. For more informa-
